About LCBI

The Low Carbon Building Initiative was launched in 2022 by major real estate players (Generali Real Estate, Covivio, BPI Real Estate, BNP Paribas Real Estate, Bouygues Immobilier, W02, Icamap, NSI, Ivanhoé Cambridge) and BBCA (Association pour le Développement du Bâtiment Bas Carbone). Its aim is to develop low-carbon certification for real estate projects in Europe, in order to accelerate the sector's decarbonization. Based on key European standards and benchmarks, the LCBI methodology aims to harmonize the practice of life cycle assessment (LCA) across Europe. Taking into account the entire life cycle, the LCBI label, audited by CERTIVEA and Bureau Veritas, measures the carbon footprint, as well as the completeness of the LCA on 3 levels: grey carbon (emissions linked to construction elements) measured in kgC02e/m² over 50 years, operating carbon (linked to energy consumption and sources) measured in kgC02e/m². The label provides for three levels of performance: Standard, Performance and Excellence.
